



## Raymond Dill

February 10, 1934 - July 28, 2016

Raymond Dill, 82, of Bokchito, OK passed away on Thursday, July 28, 2016 in Bonham, TX. He was born on February 10, 1934 in Bennington, OK to Clint and Bertha (Labor) Dill.

Raymond was a lifelong resident of Bryan County. He served in the United States Air Force from 1952 to 1956 while he also fought in the Korean War. Raymond married the love of his life, Sarah Jo (Campbell) Dill on December 19, 1955 in Bokchito, OK. He attended Beames school and later served in security as a night watchman. He enjoyed gardening and working on small engine repairs for the folks of Bokchito. Raymond was of the Baptist faith. In his younger years Raymond loved to bird hunt with his buddy Bernis Horton. He also liked fishing and his favorite past time was coaching the little league and hauling the team around in his '66 Chevy pickup with the side boards. 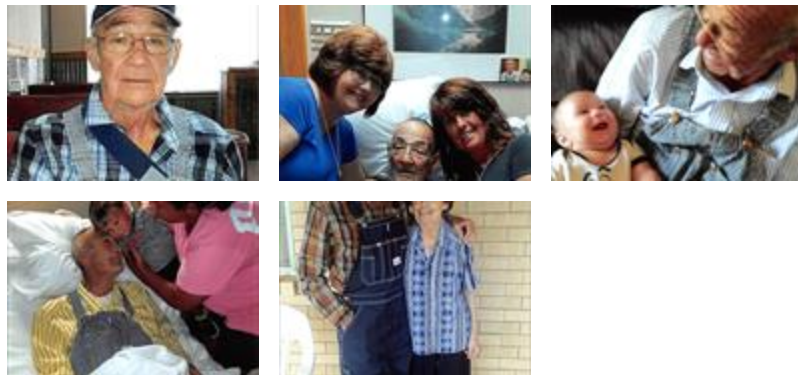
