Richard Dean Robertson Sr. of Caddo, OK passed away October 12, 2017 in Tulsa, OK at the age of 76. He was born on August 9, 1941 in Sisseton, South Dakota to Estelle May Robertson.

He was a Sisseton-Wahpeton Sioux Native American and grew up in Roberts County, South Dakota, later attending high school in Anchorage, Alaska. As a young adult and possibly earlier, he gained employment with the carnival industry. Eventually he became a ride superintendent and a great love for the carnival grew that would stay with him for always. Richard was a truck driver and a darn great one too! He loved the road, the trucks, and all his trucking buddies. He totes 56 years of trucking up/down, back/forth all over this United States.

He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. In 2008, he met his future wife, Judith Dawn Worton, and on September 5, 2009 they were married in the Sacramento Temple for Time and All Eternity. They moved to Bryan County, Oklahoma by end of 2009 where Richard continued to truck until two years ago when he retired. During his retirement he enjoyed spending time with nearby family, teaching his dogs new tricks, talking on the phone with his (long distant) friends and family, watching car races, and watching sports on television.

Though Richard had a “rough and wild” reputation most of his life, his heart was big and once you became a part of his family, you were destined to always be “his family.” Thus, he never used the term “step” when referring to any of his children, biological or otherwise.
