Richard Barnes Trevathan passed from this life on Monday, March 2, 2015 in Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 81 years, 11 months and 15 days. Richard was born on March 15, 1933 in Memphis, Tennessee to Irvin and Peggy Trevathan. Richard married Virginia Ann Lamb on April 6, 1953 in Groom, Texas and they were blessed with three children.

Richard graduated from Whitehaven High School in Memphis and continued his education at Texas A&M University and Baptist Bible College. He proudly served his country and community in the United States Air Force and was self-employed with Snap on Tools until his retirement. Later in life he was involved in buying and remodeling houses. Richard received the Carnegie hero award in 1965 for saving the life of a young man. He was a Sunday school teacher for many years as well as a Cub Scout leader. He and his wife enjoyed square dancing. He got his pilots license and soon after his own plane. He designed and built his own home where he and his wife resided for the last 26 years.

Richard was preceded in death by his parents, Irvin and Peggy Trevathan and brother, Billy Trevathan.

Richard is survived by his loving and devoted wife of 61 plus years, Virginia Trevathan of the home; beloved children, Dale Trevathan and wife Marilyn of Ft. Worth, TX, Ken Trevathan and wife Phyllis of Abilene, TX and Janet Thompson and husband Randy of Sanger, TX; sister, Peggy Ann Perkins of Germantown, TX; 6 grandchildren; 9 great grandchildren and other extended

family and friends.
