Roy Martin Godfrey of Madill, OK passed away Monday, July 30, 2018 in Northfield, Minnesota at the age of 58. He was born on October 13, 1959 in Amarillo, TX to Jack Martin Godfrey and Johnnie Beth (Culver) Godfrey.

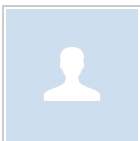
