Shirley Sue “Granny” Glover was born Monday, June 22, 1936 in Matoy, Oklahoma to Henderson Melton Turner and Ollie (Crawford) Turner. She passed from this life on Sunday, April 11, 2021 in her home at the age of 84.

Shirley Sue married Ernest Stanford “Buddy” Glover on July 28, 1952 in Durant, OK. “Granny”, known by many, worked as a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) at Oak Ridge Manor and Calera Manor for fifteen years at each facility.
