May 2, 1920 - April 7, 2014

Sidney Lee Hix, 93 of Yarnaby went to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, April 7, 2014. He was born on May 2, 1920 to James Arthur and Lora (Bowen) Hix in Yarnaby, OK. After graduating high school he went on to serve in the United States Army from July 2, 1942 to September 18, 1945. While in the Army, he was awarded the District Unit Badge, Purple Heart, Bronze Star Medal, Good Conduct Medal, and EAME Ribbon with one Silver and three Bronze Service Stars.

He married the love of his life, Geneva Greenwalt on March 26, 1949 in Sherman, TX and had just celebrated their 65th anniversary.
