Upon graduation, she was offered a job as a professor in the Business Department at S.O.S.U. where she taught Accounting for the next 10 years. Syble loved

After retirement, she enjoyed volunteering at the Senior Citizen Center and was active in her women's church group.

Syble assumed another role when her daughter was diagnosed with MS. She became Beth Ann's caregiver. She gave Beth Ann the love, encouragement and strength to preserve and continue her career even after her diagnosis.

Syble was preceded in death by her parents, Lee and Bertie Swarts; stepmother, Mary Lloyd Swarts; husband, Stub Jones; son, Bruce Sargent; sisters, Opal Green, Clarcie Dollarhide, Marie Erhardt, and Loraine Storey. She is survived by her beloved daughter Beth Ann (Jones) Maples and a number of loving nieces and nephews.
