Toy C. Marlow of Utica, Oklahoma passed away on Easter Sunday, April 8, 2012 in Durant at the age of 80 to ride his horse on the Old Chisholm Trail to meet up with his heavenly father and ride the open range with his brothers who preceded him.

Toy was born in Bokchito, Oklahoma to Charlie H. and Minnie Bell Marlow. He married Barbara Ann (Cates) on June 6, 1952 in Sherman, Texas.

Toy chose training racehorses and working as a cattle rancher, as his lifelong career. Toy had that special way with animals and could perform miracles. He loved helping everyone and spending time with his family. Riding horses was a very important part of Toy's life and continued to be throughout his retirement years. He especially enjoyed riding his horse "Jet" and helping his son feed cattle. Toy was one of the last "real" cowboys. He was also a proud tribal member of the Choctaw Nation.
