Travis Ray “Huck” Tucker fell asleep in death on October 22, 2010. He was born in Non, Oklahoma on January 28, 1941, son of Jack and Mary Tucker. He attended school in Gerdy, Holdenville and Atwood, Oklahoma and Bakersfield, California. He bought his first horse in California, a little black mare, for \$125.00 and learned to team rope there. He moved to Texas in 1973 where he won 44 saddles and 54 buckles. He dearly loved the sport and taught many young ones how to rope. He worked building chainlink fence for Allied Fence for 31 years and prided himself on being the “best fence man in the country” doing jobs by himself that normally took a crew of 5. He moved to Oklahoma in 2000 where he retired and enjoyed his ranch and cowboy “saloon”. He loved having the school children out for their field trip every year to give them chuck wagon rides and show them “Boot Hill”.

Huck leaves behind his wife Grace Tucker MD; daughter, Adrian Tucker both of the home; stepson Chris Sanders of Austin, TX; son, Timothy Tucker and wife Jolene and daughter Katharine of Bakersfield, CA; daughter, Martha Sheree Page and grandson, Dustin of Bakersfield, CA; also grandson TJ Tucker and granddaughters, Brittany Tucker of Bakersfield, CA and Deanna Tucker of Collinsville, TX. 3 siblings preceded him in death, Ruby Lucille Skaggs, Pearly Louise Walston and Roy Tucker.
