Services to celebrate the life of Vickie Marlene Haddock, 58, of Shawnee, Oklahoma who passed away April 1, 2009 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma will be held Tuesday, April 7th, 10:00 AM at the First Baptist in Caddo, Oklahoma. Pastors Paul Calmes and Glenn Pence will officiate.
