Victoria had three children; two boys and a girl. Her oldest son, Steven, passed away from Covid19 complications about two years ago. Losing a child is very difficult to overcome and I believe that it affected her through the end of her life. He had a son, one of her grandsons. She had three grandchildren from her other son, Jaysen. She had four grandchildren from her daughter. They were all her pride and joy that she supported in life to her fullest ability. She loved being with them as much as possible.

Victoria also enjoyed traveling and could not get enough. She would stay home only when she couldn't go somewhere. She had visited San Francisco, New York City, England, Bahamas, several Gulf beaches, and her relatives in several states. Visiting her relatives and grandchildren was by far, her greatest joy that she just couldn't do enough.

She enjoyed bird watching and would often go to places like Eisenhower State Park where she could see lots of wildlife and photograph it. She would take her dog Ozzie, a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel; the love of her life, with her as well as any other place she could like Walmart and Dollar General. He was with her almost 24/7.
