Virginia Dale Ball was born on March 14, 1924 in Carter, OK, and passed from this life at home on July 16 in the care of Guardian Hospice. She graduated from high school in Alison, TX where the Ball family operated a mercantile store and the telephone service. Virginia and J.E. McCathern, Jr. married on March 30, 1941. While J.E. was drafted into the Army in 1944, Virginia attended beauty school in Amarillo where she became a licensed beautician. In 1947 the family moved to Hereford, Texas where Virginia worked for a short time in the family beauty shop. In addition to being an expert cook, housekeeper, beautician, and gardener, Virginia was an excellent seamstress. The retired couple moved to Lake Texoma in 1997. They celebrated their 92nd and 95th birthdays in March and April, but most remarkably, their 75th Wedding Anniversary on March 30, 2016.

In addition to her husband J.E. and three children, Jenny, Jerry and Joy, Virginia Dale Ball McCathern is survived by seven grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.
