William Clyde Osterhaus 98, of Madill, Oklahoma passed away March 16, 2017. He was born November 19, 1918 in Norman, Oklahoma. He grew up in Waurika, Oklahoma where he met his Soul Mate. He attended Central State Collage in Edmond, Oklahoma for two years before marrying his Soul Mate Arliene Osterhaus.

He joined the United States Army where He served 3 years as a part of the Signal Corp. He spent 21 months of those 3 years serving his country in WORLD WAR II from Normandy through to the end of Hostilities where he served under General Patton and earned five Campaign Stars and a Bronze Star medal fit Meritorius Service. He received the European African-Middle Eastern Service Medal, and the Good Conduct Medal. After returning home from WWII He and the love of his life moved to Madill, Okla. In 1947 they built the Return Motel and ran it until 1980 when they sold it and bought their dream place out on Lake Texoma where he and his Lovely Bride spent 30 years watching their ever changing panoramic view and enjoying life. He worked as a traveling salesman for Homer Miller Company for many of those years. He and Arliene enjoyed traveling all 50 states in the RV.

He is preceded in death by his parents and wife of 72 years Arliene Osterhaus where he is now reunited with her.
